To share industry experiences and expertise on construction site management, highlighting challenges and solutions.

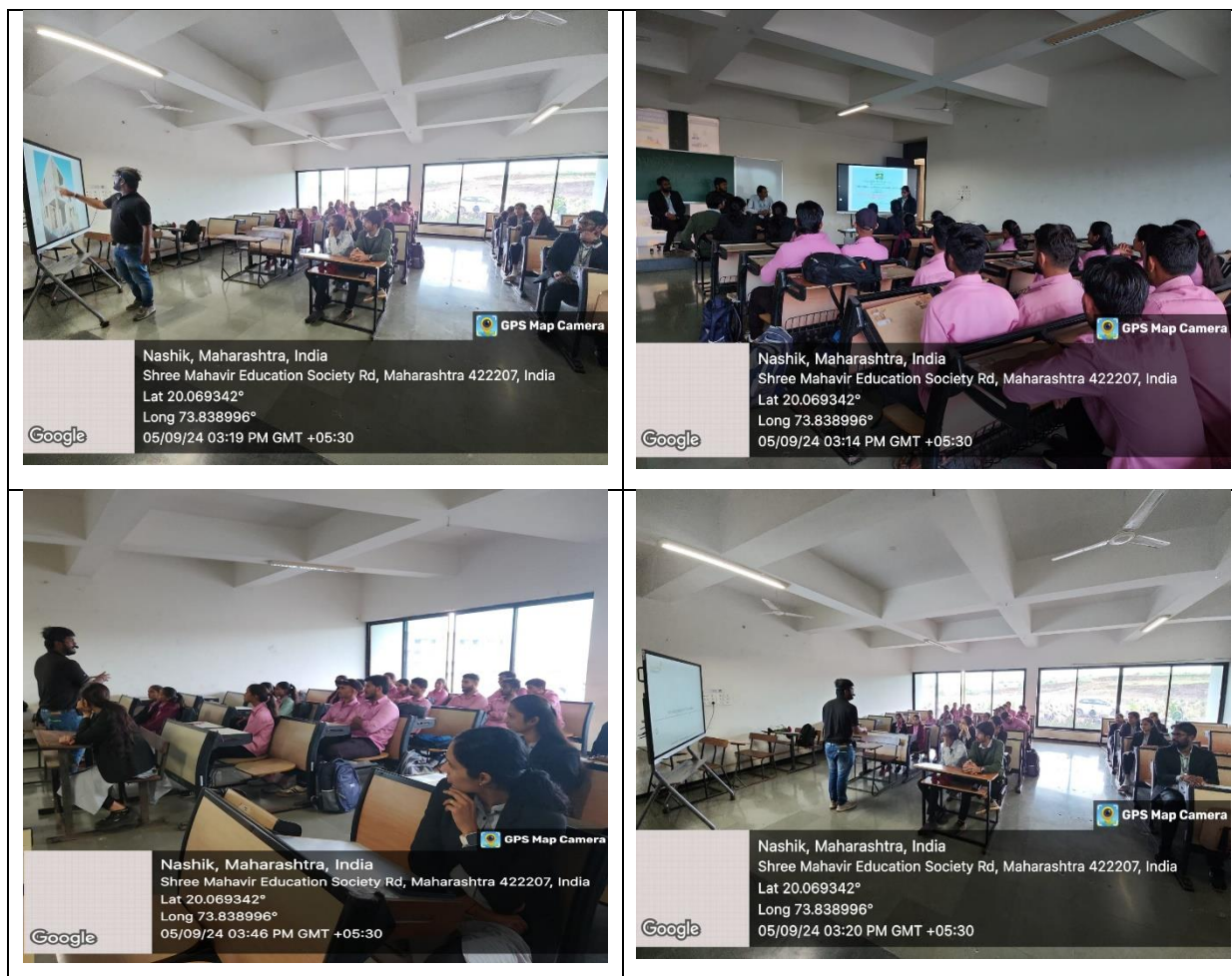
Description / Explanation of the Program:
