


# 'Let's master new skills of become positive, wiser and fearless by embracing change.'



Civil Engineering students of Third Year visited Metrological Rain Gauge Station Nashik, The Objective of this Industrial visit was to understand and study of instruments like ARGS, Thermometers, and Wind Vane and other instruments of hydrology and water resource subject. As an output students observed the practical use of these Instruments.



Electrical Engineering students of Second Year visited Karanjwan Dam, which is an earthfill dam on Kadwa river near Dindori , Maharashtra. The Objective of Industrial visit was to understand construction and working of Hydro Power Plant and observe the plant to realize practical implementation of theory learnt in the class. Karanjwan Dam, is an earth fill dam on Kadwa river. The gross storage capacity of the dam is 175580 km3 . It is mainly used for generating Electricity and for irrigation. As a output students observed a working hydro power plant and its all stages of the generation. They saw different components at different stages and the control unit for controlling the working of the plant. They learnt about different phases such as running plant, maintenance and shutdown of the plant.

Students studied about the pumping systems having centrifugal pumps used for Municipal Corporation water distribution.

Imagination. I congratulate all the team and family of Mahavir for the initiative taken for starting the VOICES. Being pharmacist let me say something about pharmacy profession Pharmacy is one of the important professions of Healthcare which caters to of patient-centric approach providing pharmaceutical care to the consumers. The core thrust areas of Pharmacy include Science and Practice of Pharmacy, viz., formulation development, analysis of drugs and in-process quality control of medicines during manufacturing process, providing life to medicines by improving their shelf life during storage, along with practicing the concepts of Pharmacy for better quality of life of patients by community and clinical pharmacists working in Pharmacy stores and Hospitals.

The main subjects of pharmacy are divided into Pharmaceutics (the science of dosage form design), Pharmaceutical Chemistry (dealing with synthesis, identification and analysis of drugs), Pharmacology (dealing with how drugs act in the body and how they are absorbed, distributed in body fluids, metabolized and excreted out from the body) and Pharmacognosy (that deals with the drugs that are obtained from natural sources).

Students after graduating B. Pharm finds a wide array of options for their employment, viz., in (Production, QC/QA, Microbiology/ Analytical laboratory/ Packaging), Marketing and Sales (Biomedical Devices/ Sophisticated Analytical Instruments/ Medicines), Clinical Research (Clinical Associate/ Pharmacovigilance Associate/ Medical Writer), Drugs Inspector or can become entrepreneur by starting one's own industry or a Pharmacy Store to practice Community pharmacy. They can also find employment in Government (Railway, Police, Defence) and Private Hospitals as Pharmacists. Students can also opt for Higher Education in Research (M. Pharm.).



Spectrophotometric Method for Estimation of Cyproheptadine hydrochloride. The developed U.V methods were found to be more accurate, precise and reproducible. This validation parameter of these methods shows good results. The recovery studies revealed excellent accuracy and high precision of the method. The methods were found to be simple, safe and economical. These methods could be applied for routine analysis in quality control laboratories and also it will useful in stability study of drug by using UV spectrophotometric method.
